The 57 year-old abused his Position to take the Lives of mainly Elderly Women by giving them Lethal Doses of Drugs. His Crimes were discovered in 1998 after he attempted to forge a £386,000 Will of one of his Victims, Kathlees Grundy, 81. He was convicted in January 2000 and sentenced to life in Prison. He was found hanging in his Cell in Wakefield Prison on Jan 13, 2004.
